The Parish Pastoral Council invite you to a screening of *The Letter* in the Parish centre on Mountain View Road on Tuesday 26th March at 7.00pm.

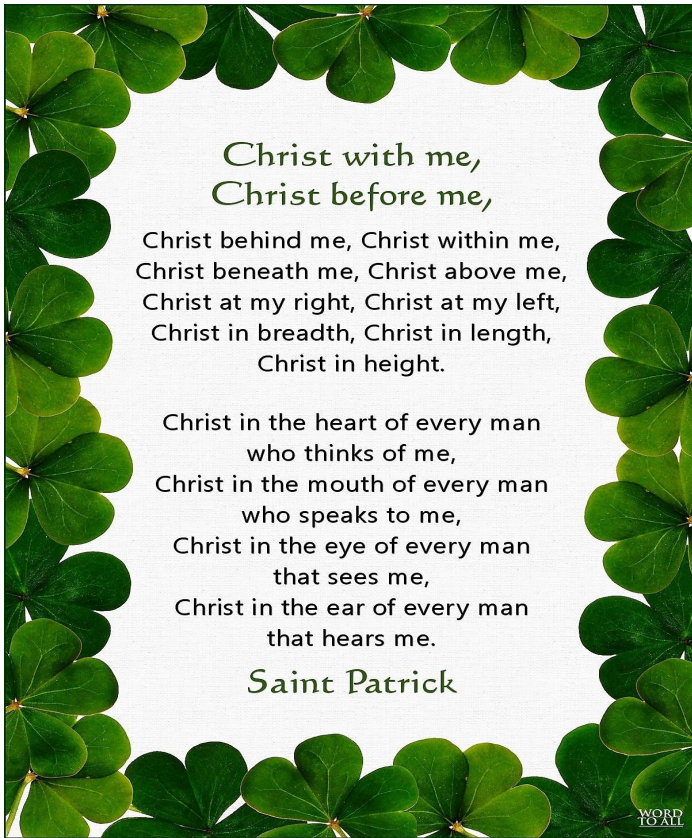
