In November we remember

The month of November gives us the opportunity to remember our dear departed when we enter their names on the Altar List of the Dead, so that they may be prayed for at all Masses during November and on the First Friday of each month for the coming year. If you wish to have the names of your loved ones on the list, there are envelopes at the back of the church. These can be returned in the collection bags at Mass or to the Parish Office or sacristy. Contributions and donations for the November List of the Dead go directly to support your local clergy when they offer prayers and Masses. Your generous support is very much appreciated.

Our annual Mass for our deceased parishioners takes place on Sunday 3rd November at 6.00pm. All are very welcome.

What are Indulgences?

Over the centuries a tremendous amount of good works and acts of kindness have been done by people of faith in Jesus Christ. These can be seen as a great deposit of goodness using the image of a 'treasury of goodness'. On the other hand, there may be many people who while basically loving of God and neighbour may be lacking in Christian love in some particular ways and after their death they cannot make up that deficit by themselves. Through indulgences the 'surplus' of goodness can be given to those who may be lacking in love of God or neighbour. This transfer is organised through the authority of the Church.

Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls.

1. From 12 o'clock noon on the 1st of November until midnight on the 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a Church or Oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.

This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st to 8th November.

2. The faithful who visit a Cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
